JOB TITLE: First Responder

GENERAL DUTIES:

To support the Town of Wilson First Responder Unit in all activities including emergency response, training, fundraising, maintenance, recruiting, board meetings and other special activities.

MINIMUM COMMITMENT:

The ability to want to help your neighbor and serve your community.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The below responsibilities are specific duties expected of the position.

- Respond to emergency EMS call situations of all types, personal injury, motor vehicle accidents, ice/water rescue, general community assistance, and fire rehab.
- Tasks at emergency scenes may include, life saving practices to the fullest extent, assisting Town of Wilson Black River Fire Department and fire rehab.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Below are the minimum qualifications for the position.

- Minimum of 18 years of age Clean and neat appearance Sound physical condition Not convicted of a felony
- Pass a probationary period of 90 days
- Not required to live inside Town of Wilson Township

TIME REQUIREMENT:

Initial training course at Lakeshore Technical College consisting of 70 hours to achieve First Responder. This course is mandatory. Once initial training is complete to stay active as a First Responder a minimum of 8 business meetings and 8 training drills per year. The drill/meeting schedule is as follows; 2 drills/meetings per month. One on the first Thursday (training) of the month and one on the third Thursday (business meeting) of the month both events begin at 6:00 PM. Some Saturday and additional training sessions are available throughout the year.

BENEFITS:

In addition to great personal satisfaction for your involvement in community service you will receive attendance to all First Responder functions to include Annual Banquet, golf outings and family picnic days. First Responders receive an official Town of Wilson First Responders uniform shirt; Town of Wilson First Responders T-shirt, one department casual jacket; enrollment in the Wisconsin State EMS Association, free training opportunities and special recognition awards. All training and initial equipment including gear and personal apparel is provided at no cost.
