

DOG LICENSES

Dog licenses are available year round for the current year. The license is valid January 1st through December 31st of the current year.

A copy of the current **Rabies Vaccination Certificate** indicating if the dog is neutered or spayed must be presented with the payment of the dog license tax.

Dog neutered or spayed..... \$7/dog
Dog non-neutered/non-spayed..... \$14/dog

- A \$25 late fee will be assessed for each licensable dog that is not licensed by March 31, or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog.
- If your puppy (dog) becomes 5 months of age after July 1st, then the license is half the full year cost for the current year.

By State Statute (174.05), the owner of a dog (that is kept in the Town of Wilson) which dog is more than 5 months of age on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year, shall annually, or on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age, pay the dog license tax and obtain a license (at the Town of Wilson office). The owner acquiring a new dog greater than 5 months of age must obtain a license within 30 days of acquiring ownership.
