SECTION 1 GENERAL

1.01 Wages-Commissioners

The Town Board members are the Commissioners and serve in this capacity. The Town Board sets the wages for the Commissioners. Changes to the wages must be documented in the minutes of the meetings and set prior to the adoption of the annual budget. If at any time the Town Board wishes to appoint Commissioners to serve the Sanitary District that are not Town Board members, the Commissioners must reside in the Sanitary District and the Town Board can determine the wages to be paid to Commissioners if they are not Town Board members

1.02 Expenses

The Commissioners shall be reimbursed for expenses accrued for out-of-town meetings, actual expenses for costs including meals and mileage for Sanitary District business.

1.03 Accountants

Financial records of the Sanitary District shall be reviewed with an annual financial report to be presented at the Annual Meeting of the Town held each April.

1.04 Additions to District

The Sanitary District shall conduct necessary public hearings and surveys for additions to the District. All costs incurred by the Town or the Sanitary District for legal fees, publication fees, etc., shall be paid by the petitioner requesting the addition to the Sanitary District.

1.05 Plumber Required

All plumbing work shall be subject to the Town's current requirements for building permits. Property owners may plumb the interior of structures and may dig exterior excavations but a licensed plumber must be utilized for exterior laying of pipe and connections to the District's sewer system. Inspections will be performed by the District's plumbing inspector.

1.06 Plumbing Permit

No plumbing permit shall be issued for new construction until the Town issues a building permit and all permit charges and connection fees are paid.

1.07 Portable Toilets

Portable toilets may be used on golf courses, construction sites, and temporarily used for picnics, festivals or similar events in the District except all permanent buildings shall be connected to the sewer system.
