Notice is hereby given that the Town of Wilson will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 20, 2019 at 6:30 pm on the petitions by Wisconsin Power and Light (WP&L / Alliant), WJB Associates, RJL Property Sheboygan, LLC, Zimbal Minkery, Inc., and Spiro Bros. LLC for properties located along the Frontage Road (generally parcel numbers 59030454241, 59030454242, 59030454040, 59030453995, 59030453981 and 59030453986) for annexation into the Town of Wilson Sanitary District no. 1.
