LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on March 20, 2020, the Town of Wilson Town Board adopted a Resolution Declaring Emergency, which declared an emergency within the Town of Wilson as a result of the novel coronavirus (Covid-19). The purpose of the Resolution was to establish a Coronavirus Emergency Response Plan. A full copy of the Plan is available by contacting Town Clerk Julie Wicker at 920-208-2390 or jwicker@townwilson.com. The Plan prohibits the use of the Town office, Town Hall, and Town maintenance building for any purpose other than to process absentee ballots, participate in early voting, or handle any emergencies that arise. The Plan further establishes protocols for remotely conducting all other essential Town business including permit applications, license applications, and payments for all other types of services. Under the Plan, nonessential Town meetings will be suspended indefinitely, optional Town meetings will either be cancelled or held electronically, and essential Town meetings will be conducted remotely or by moving them to the larger Town Hall where appropriate social distancing can be accommodated.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Resolution is enforceable by penalties and forfeitures in the event of any violations.
