CHAPTER 6

TOWN OF WILSON SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN

CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Wilson, at a duly noticed public meeting with quorum present and voting, hereby ordains the following:

Section 1: Code Enforcement Officer.

- (a) Office of Constable Abolished. The office of Town Constable has been abolished by the electors.
- (b) Code Enforcement Officer. The position of Code Enforcement Officer is hereby created. The Code Enforcement Officer or any additional Code Enforcement Officers shall be appointed by the Town Board and shallserve at the pleasure of the Town Board.
- (c) Power and Duties. The Town Code Enforcement Officer(s) shall act on the behalf of the Town to:
 - (i) Investigate, respond to complaints, cause prosecution of violations of the Town ordinances as set forth in the ordinances, or as assigned or directed by the Town Board, these powers and duties being further described in the job description for the Code Enforcement Officer, which may be amended from time to time;
 - (ii) Any and such other responsibilities as assigned by the Town Board relating to the health, welfare, and safety of the Town of Wilson.
- (d) Any reference in any other ordinances of the Town of Wilson Municipal Code to "Constable", shall be interpreted to refer to the duties of the Code Enforcement Officer(s).

Section 2: Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be effective upon enactment and publication as required by law. This ordinance repeals the existing Chapter 6 of the Code of Ordinances in effect as of the date of this Ordinance.

Section 3: Directive to Town Clerk and Town Attorney.

The Town Clerk and Town Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary to implement the terms of this ordinance.
