CHANGES TO TOWN OFFICE ACCESS

The Town of Wilson offices are OPEN to the public effective immediately M-Th 8:00 to 4:30 PM. Masks and social distancing are still strongly recommended for the safety of our staff and residents. As you know, conditions and plans can change rapidly, and the Town Board reserves the right to reinstate more stringent safety measures in the event of a COVID surge or significant increase in COVID cases in Sheboygan County. This might include closing the town office to residents and/or requiring masking and social distancing while in the building. Accordingly, we will be diligent in updating our plans as conditions warrant and to communicate those updates to you in a timely manner.

CHANGES TO HOW WE CONDUCT TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

We are working on moving to a hybrid approach for town public meetings where you can attend in person or remotely by computer or phone. In person meetings will be held at the larger town. Joining by computer or smart phone will provide both video and audio access to meetings. If you join using any other phone you will be limited to audio access only.
