## SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 1 COMMISSIONERS MEETING TOWN OF WILSON, SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN MINUTES OF September 18th, 2023

CALL TO ORDER & DECLARATION OF OPEN MEETING: President Fore called the Sanitary District No.1 Commissioners Meeting to order at 5:38 p.m. Posting in accordance with open meeting law was confirmed by affidavit of posting and the meeting was declared an open meeting. ## **NEW BUSINESS / APPOINTMENTS:**

- 1. Approval of draft minutes for September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023 SD1 Commissioner's Meeting Motion by Hoffmann, second by DesJardins to approve the draft minutes for the September 5th, 2023 Commissioner's meeting, All members voted Aye. Motion carried.
- 2. Maintenance issues as reported by Ben Darkow and/or Otis Kiehl Darkow reported that manhole work will be started on Sherwood on Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> of September.

The two large projects relate to Indian Mound Road and the Lakeshore Pump Station.
